

Books by Marquis James

- 1923 *A History of the American Legion*. New York: W. Green. James's first book, written while he was editing the American Legion magazine.
- 1929 *The Raven: A Biography of Sam Houston*. Indianapolis: Bobbs-Merrill. James's first major biography and the winner of the 1929 Pulitzer Prize in biography. It marks the first in a long line of books that he published with Bobbs-Merrill. A Modern edition was published in 1990 by the Book-of-the-Month club, New York. Introduction by Robert M. Utley.
- 1931 (With Bessie Rowland James) *Six Feet Six*. A children's book about Sam Houston.
- 1933 *Andrew Jackson: The Border Captain*. Indianapolis: Bobbs-Merrill.
- 1934 *They Had Their Hour*. Indianapolis: Bobbs-Merrill. Dramatic episodes in American history written for popular consumption.
(With Bessie Rowland James) *The Courageous Heart*. A biography of Andrew Jackson for young readers.
- 1937 *Andrew Jackson: Portrait of a President*. Indianapolis: Bobbs-Merrill.
- 1938 *The Life of Andrew Jackson*. Indianapolis: Bobbs-Merrill. Combines *The Border Captain* (1933) and *Portrait of a President* (1937) into one volume, which one James his second Pulitzer Prize for biography.
- 1939 *Mister Garner of Texas*. Indianapolis: Bobbs-Merrill. A biography of John Nance Garner, who served as vice president of the United States during Franklin Roosevelt's first two terms.
- 1941 *Alfred I. DuPont: The Family Rebel*. Indianapolis: Bobbs-Merrill. Commissioned by the DuPont family, this was the first of James's many books in the genre of business history. All of his subsequent works, with the exception of his autobiography, were commissioned or contracted.
- 1942 *Biography of a Business, 1792-1942: Insurance Company of North America*. Indianapolis: Bobbs-Merrill.
- 1945 *The Cherokee Strip: A Tale of an Oklahoma Boyhood*. New York: Viking. James's recollections of his youth. This was his first book with Viking, breaking with his old publisher, Bobbs-Merrill.
- 1947 *The Metropolitan Life: A Study in Business Growth*. New York: Viking.
- 1953 *The Texaco Story: The First Fifty Years, 1902-1952*. New York: Texaco.
- 1954 (With Bessie Rowland James.) *Biography of a Bank: The Story of Bank of American, N.T. & S.A.* New York: Harper and Brothers.
- 1993 *Merchant Adventurer: The Story of W.R. Grace*. W. R. Grace and Co. Commissioned by W. R. Grace and Co in 1944 and completed in 1948. The book was scheduled for release in October of 1948 when suddenly W. R. Grace decided not to publish it. The manuscript was finally published in 1993 some 45 years later after being discovered by historian Lawrence A. Clayton in the archives of the W. R. Grace and Co.
